




Slide notes: We can set up new, and maintain existing Triggers, at the Alerter menu.





Slide notes: To maintain existing Triggers for the current Datamart, we can choose 'Amend'.



Slide notes: The system will list any existing Triggers for the User in this Datamart.






Slide notes: Once we select a Trigger, we may modify or remove the Trigger, or we may simply quit and leave it as it is in the current state.





Slide notes: To define a new Trigger, we just choose 'new'.



Slide notes: From the list of available Trigger types, we select the Trigger we wish to set up.




Slide notes: Some trigger types may have additional fields to complete, and others, like this one, can simply be saved to complete the set up of the Trigger.






