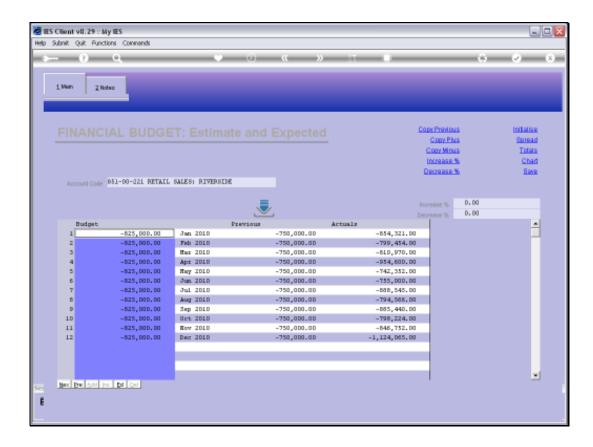


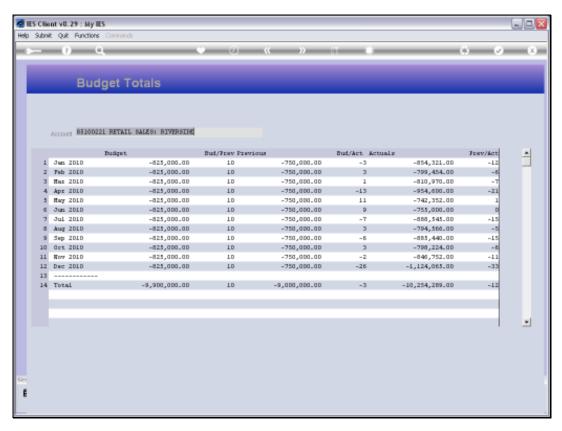
Slide 1

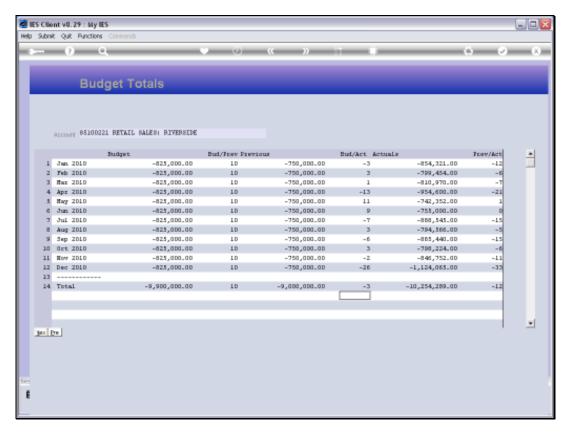

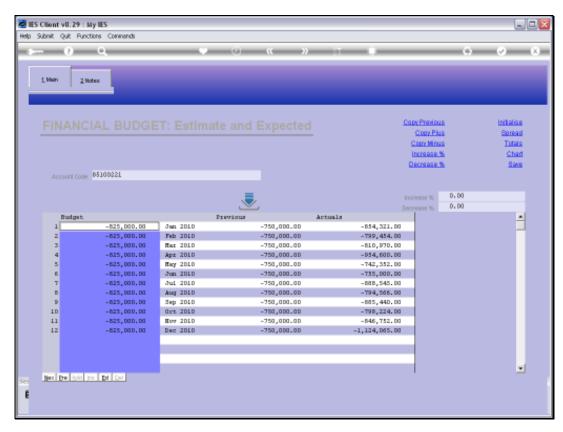

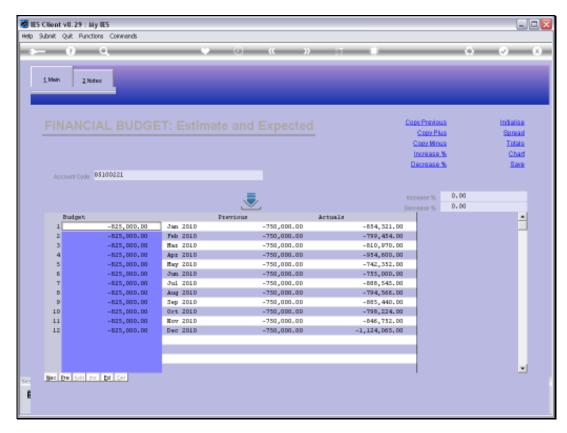
