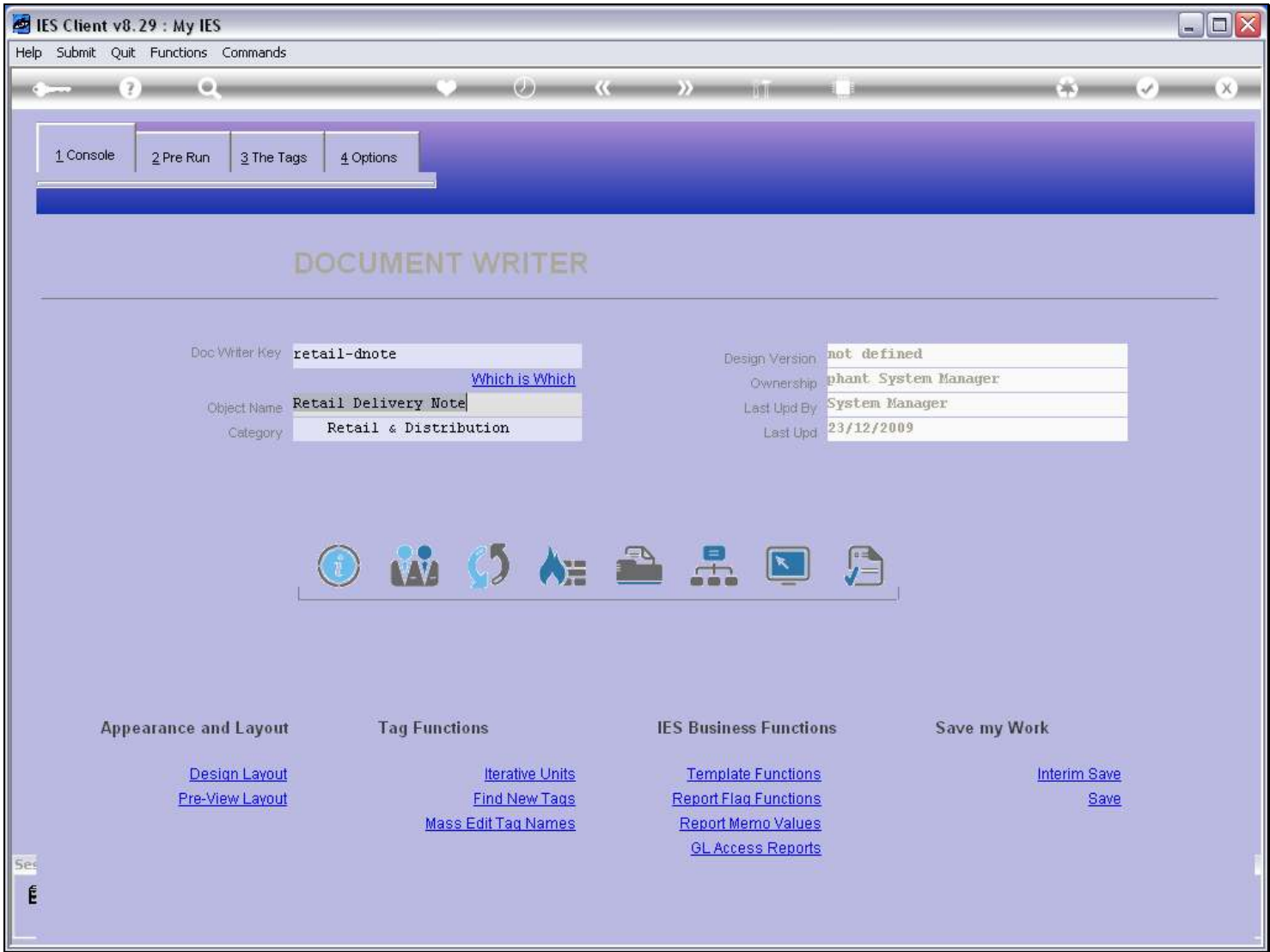


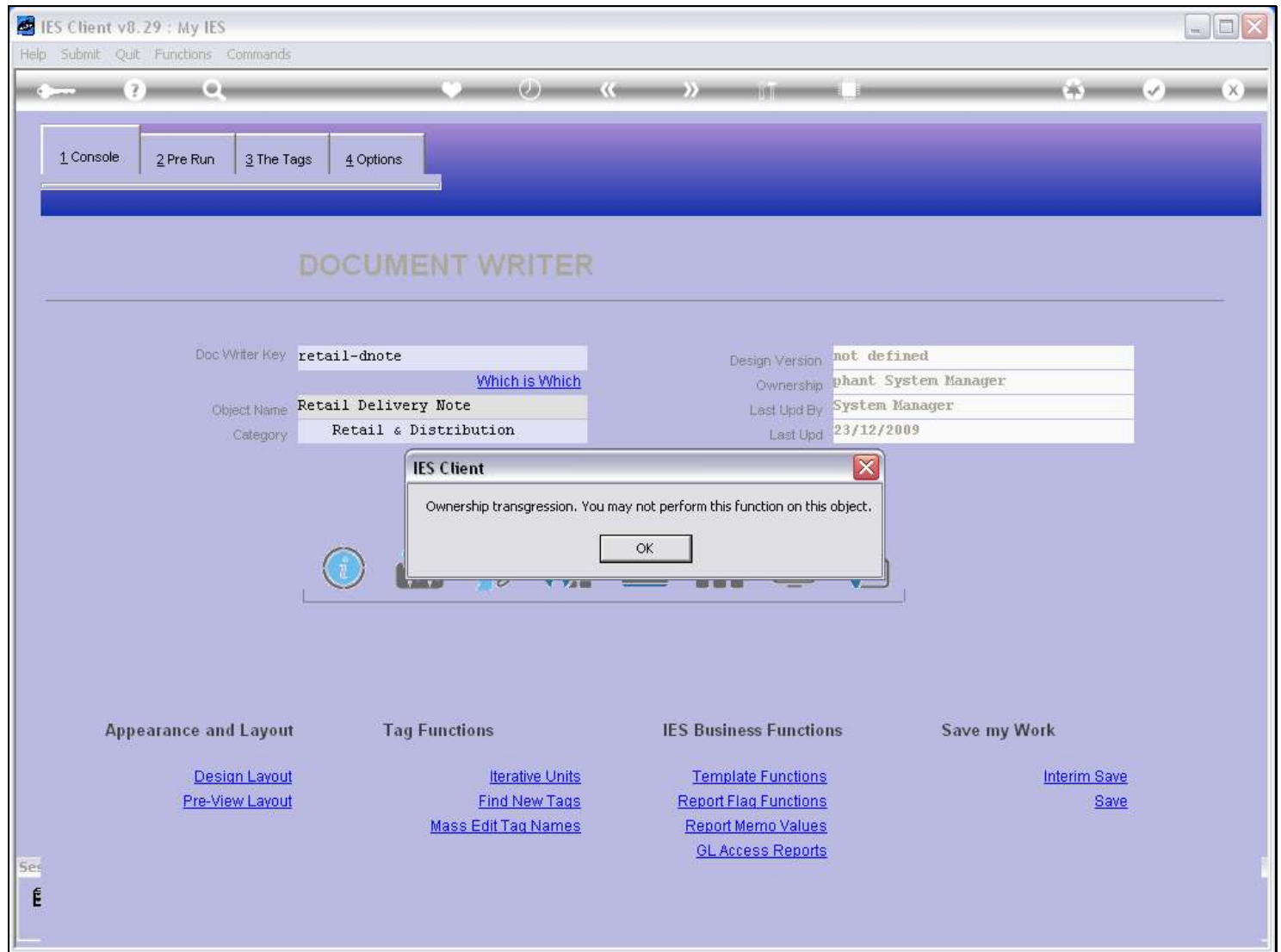

DocWriter has a Removal function to delete the Report.

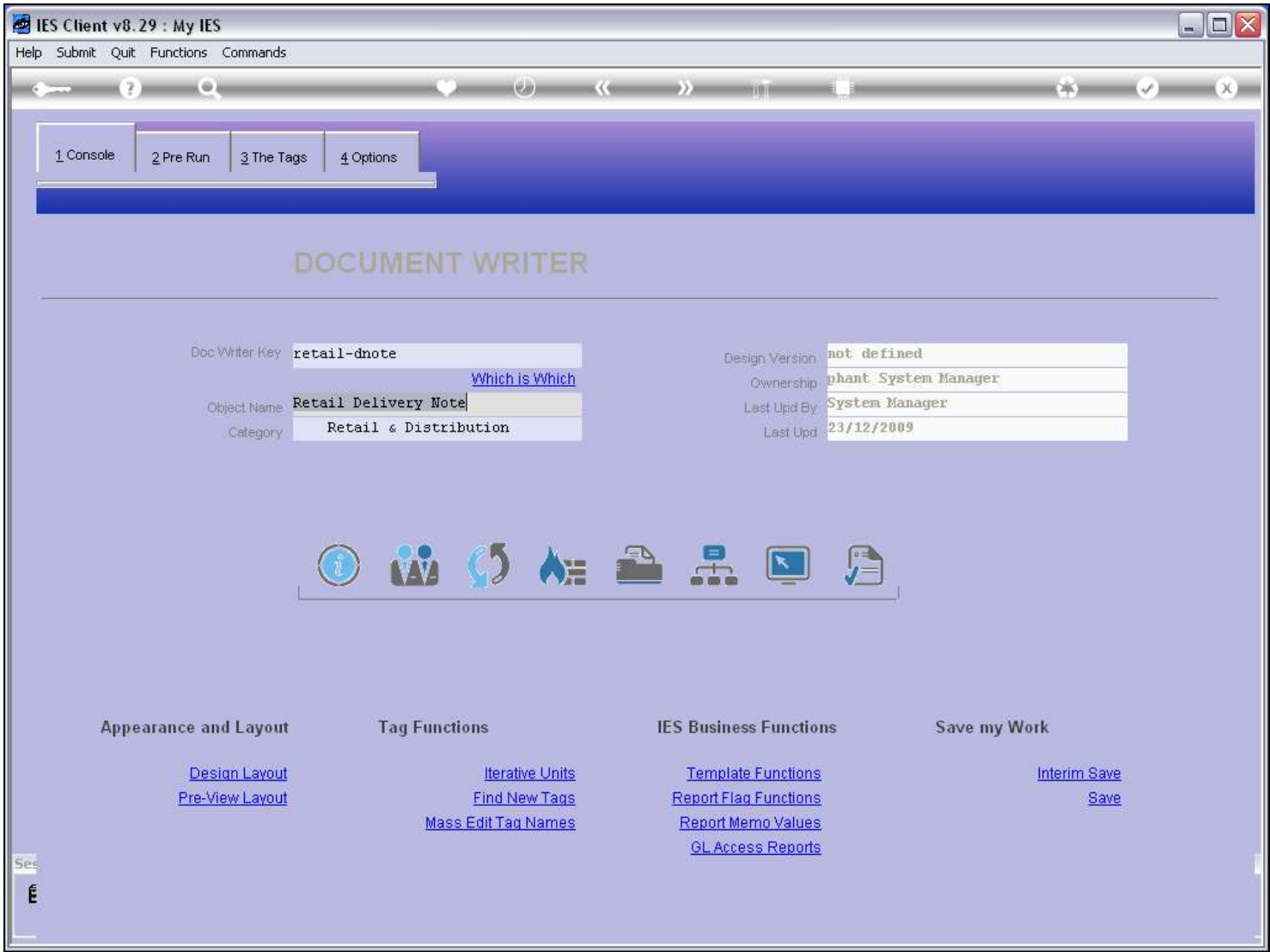

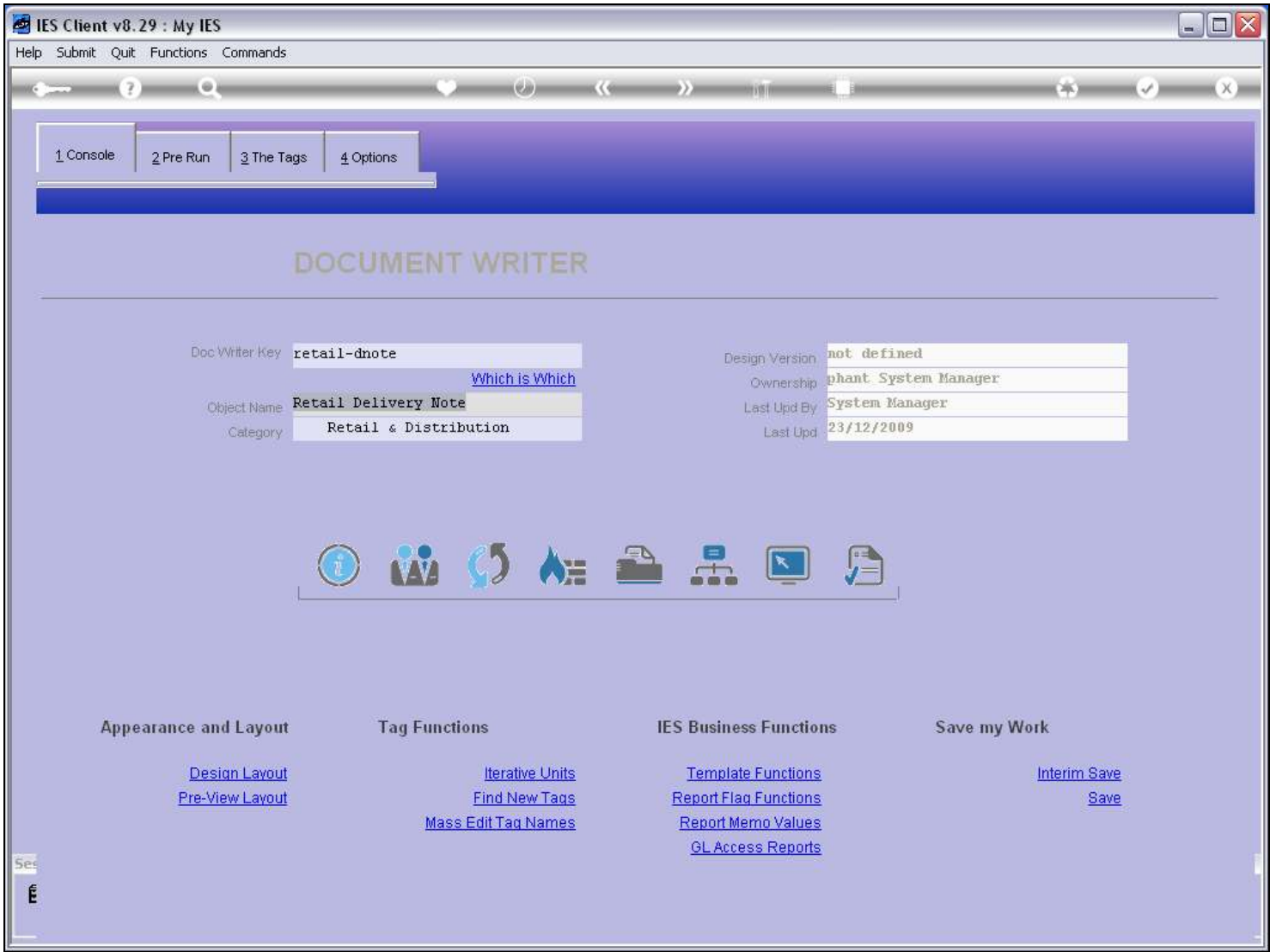
Of course, removal is subject to rules. In the 1st instance, we must be within the ownership domain of the Report to remove it.

So the current User is Terry, and the Report is owned by the System Manager, and that's why I cannot delete this Report.

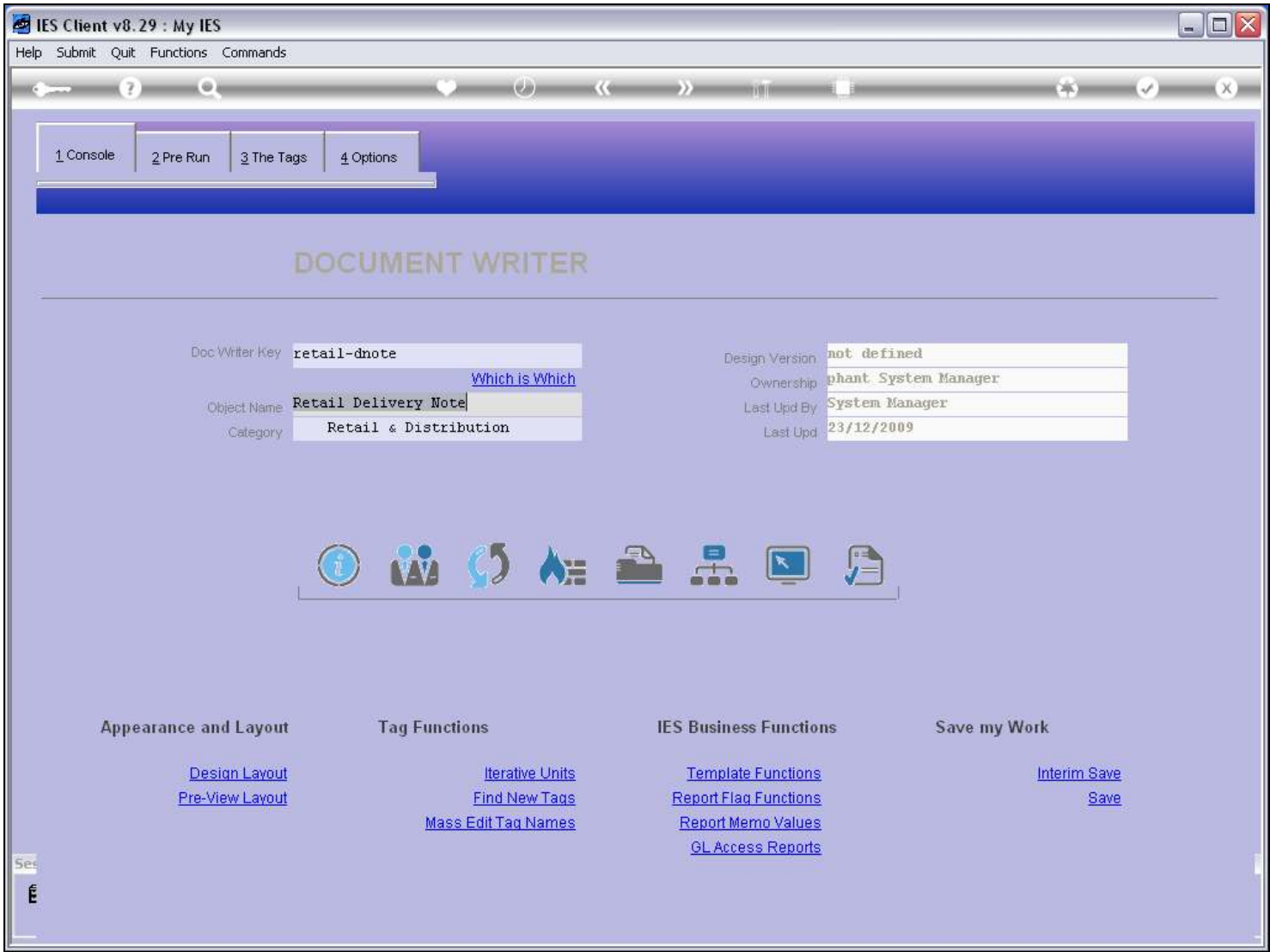

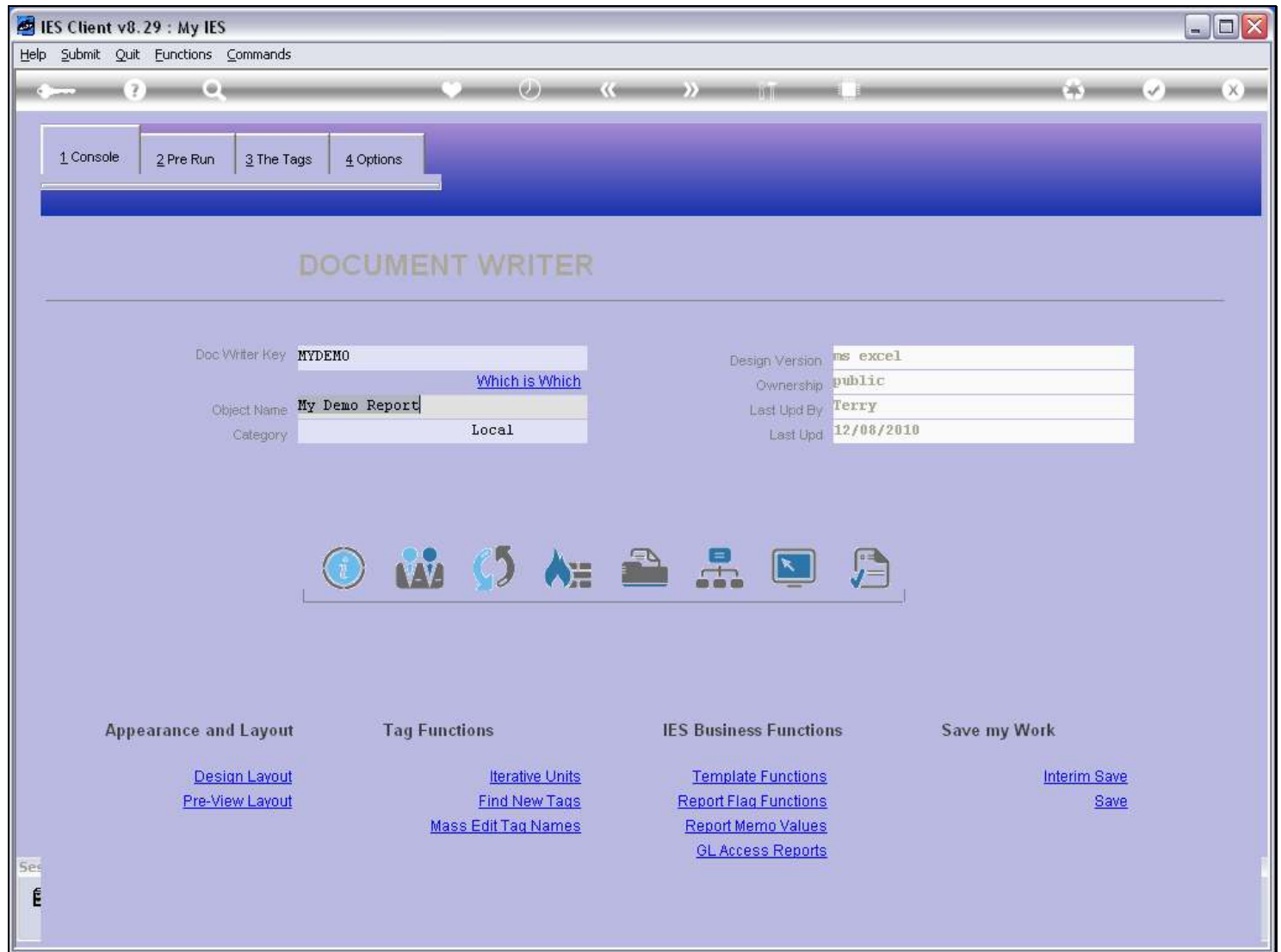
When the Report is in use as a Swap, it also cannot be deleted, so we will have to delete the Swap first.

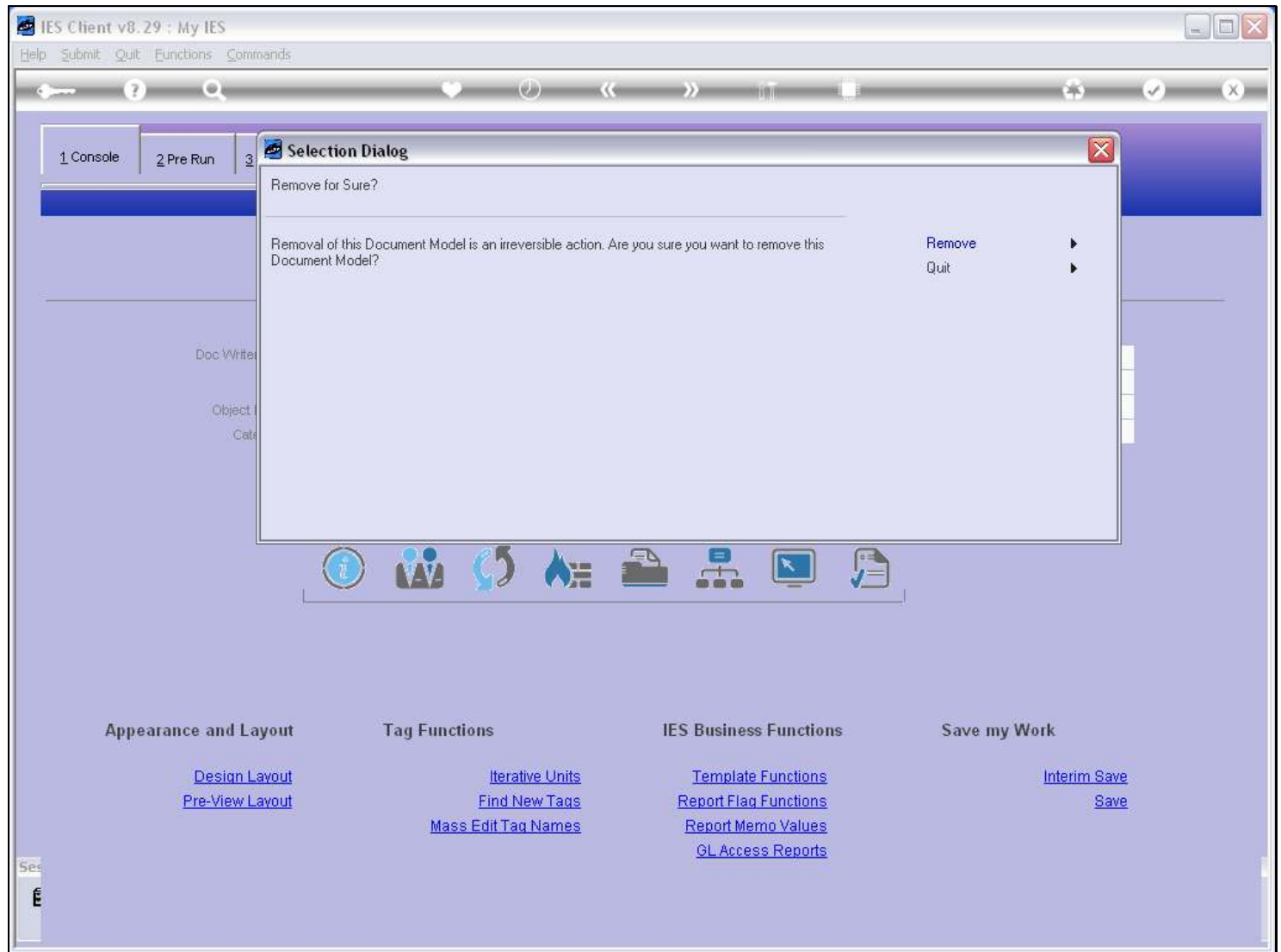
