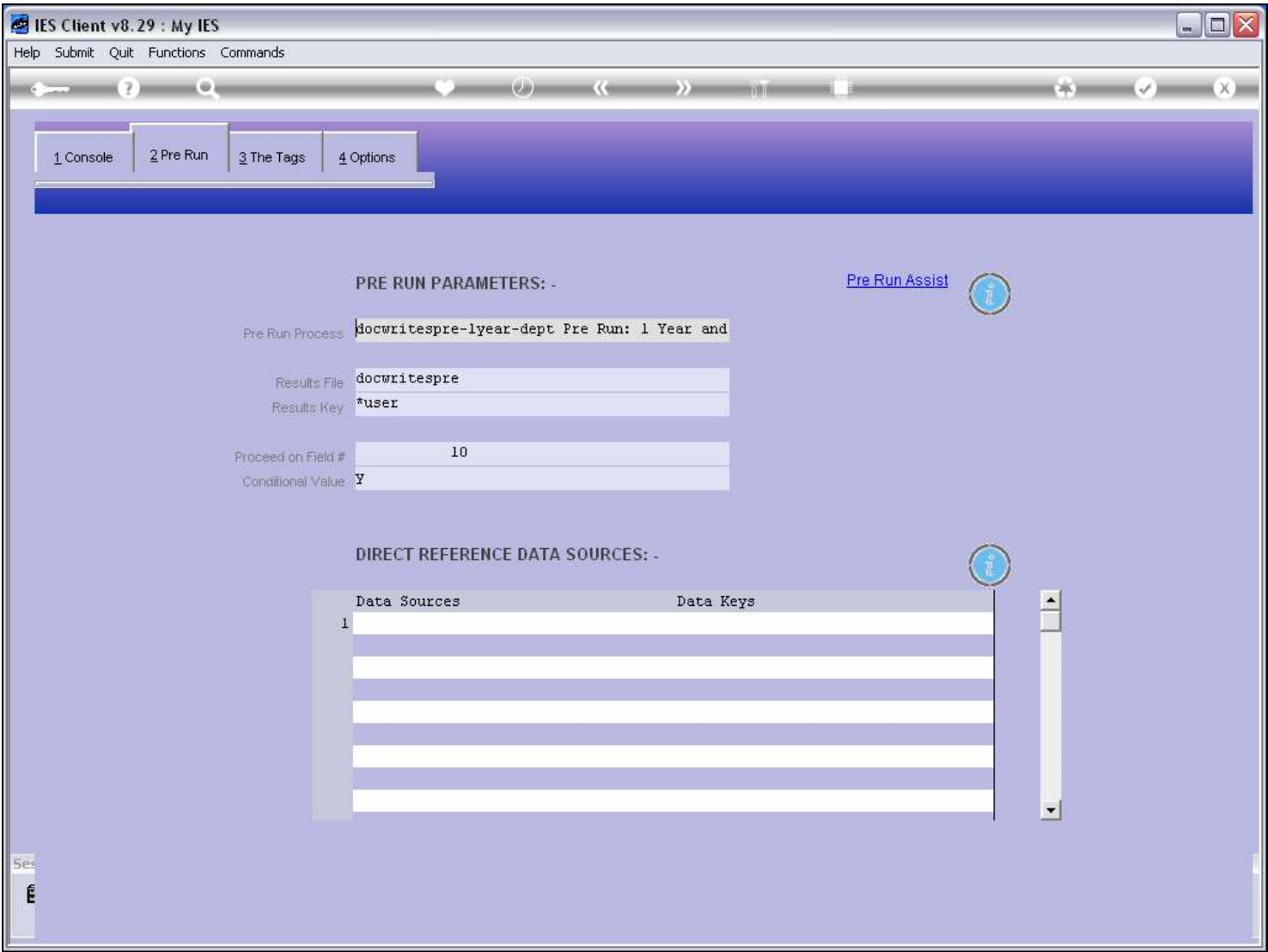
When we select a standard Pre Run, then it completes the necessary fields and that's that. So when we test our Report, we'll see the Pre Run kick in.
