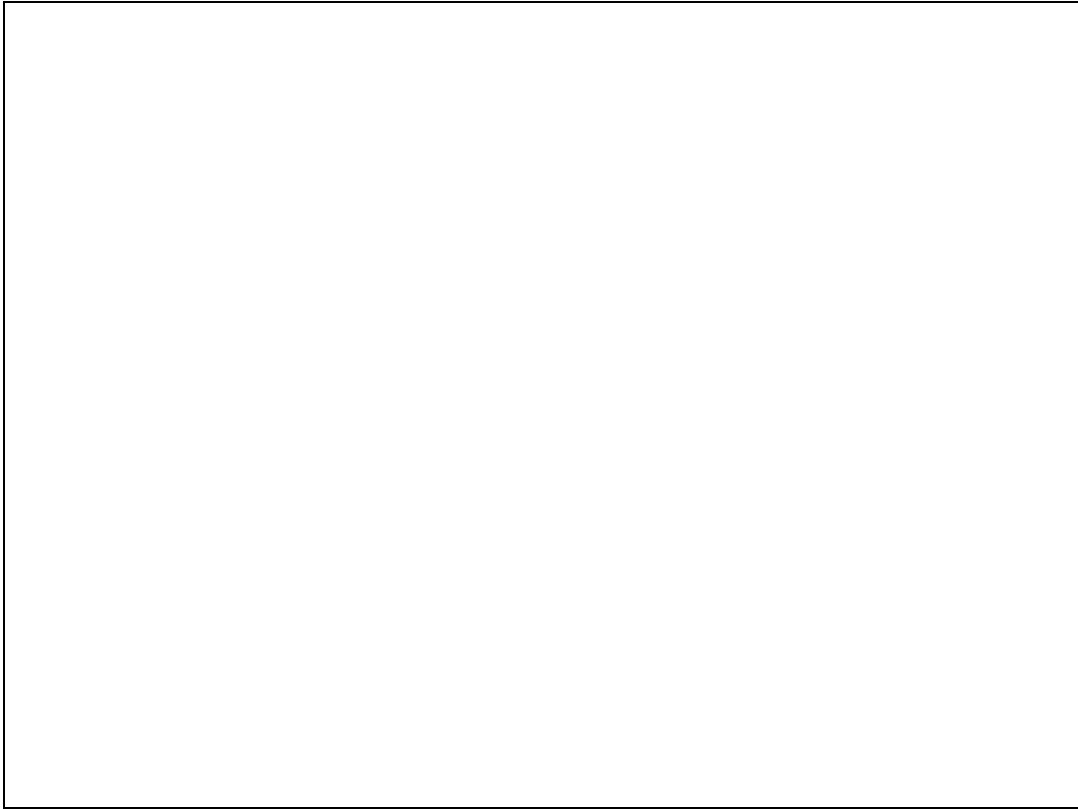


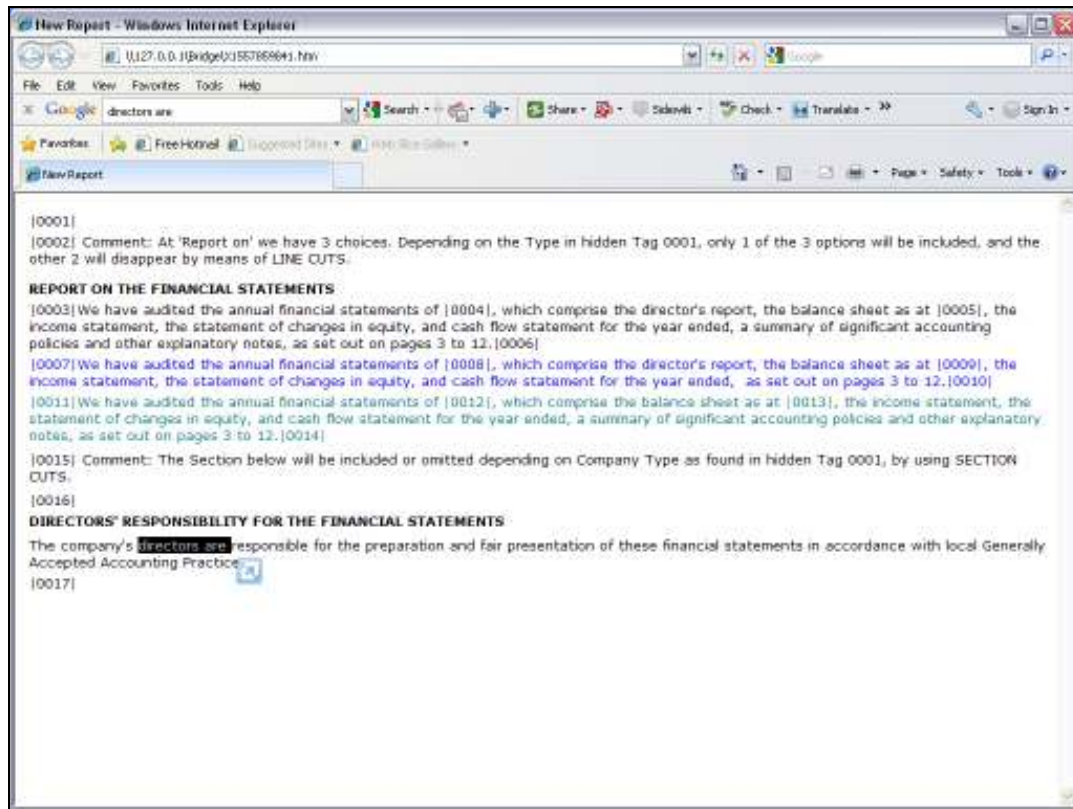
Slide 1

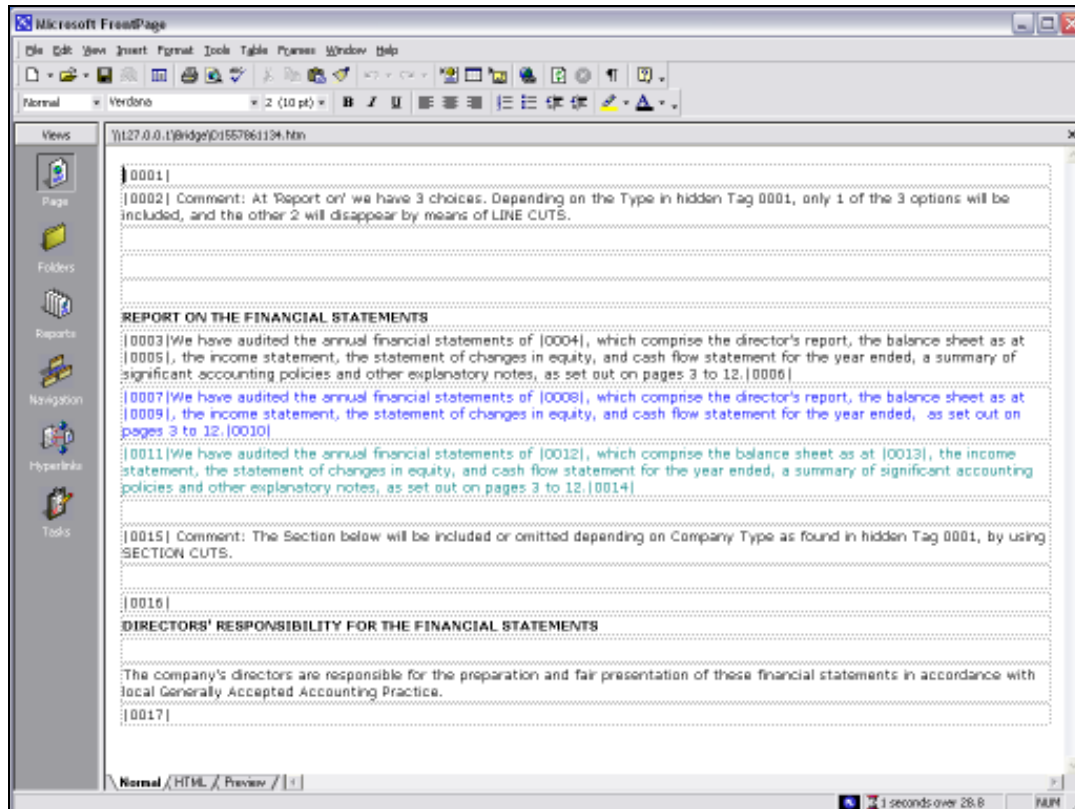

Slide notes: Where we are saying 'directors are' we wish to say 'director is' when there is only 1 Director in the Company.



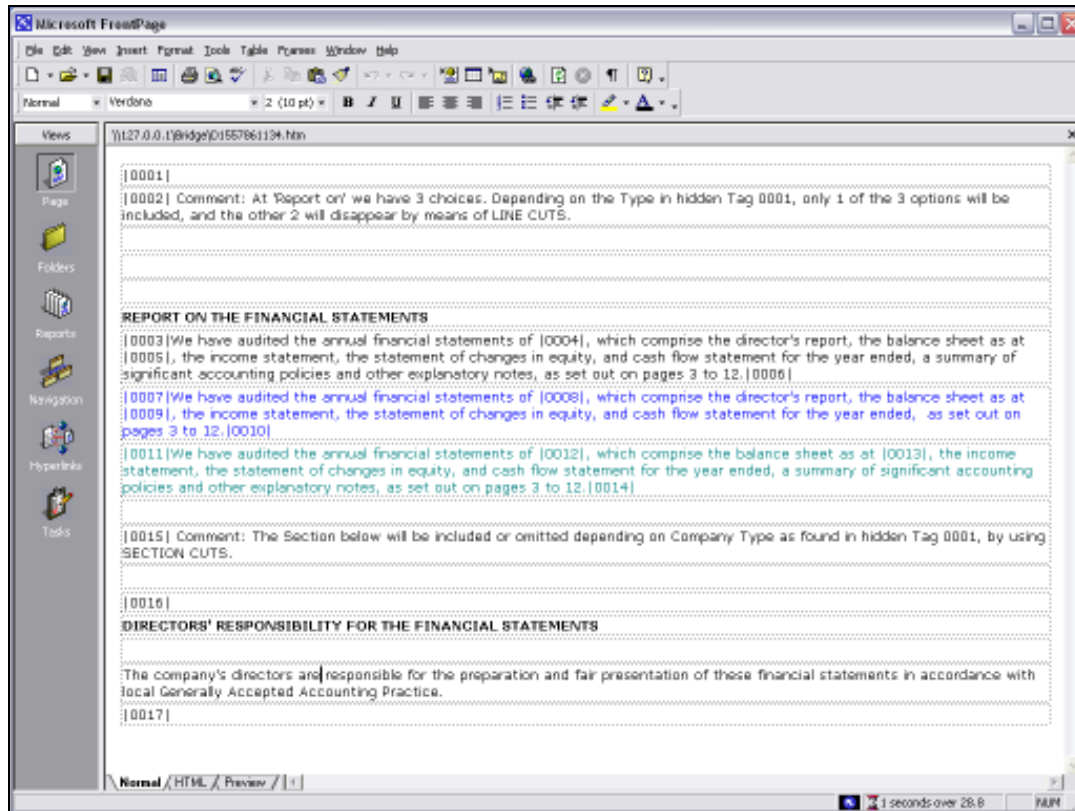

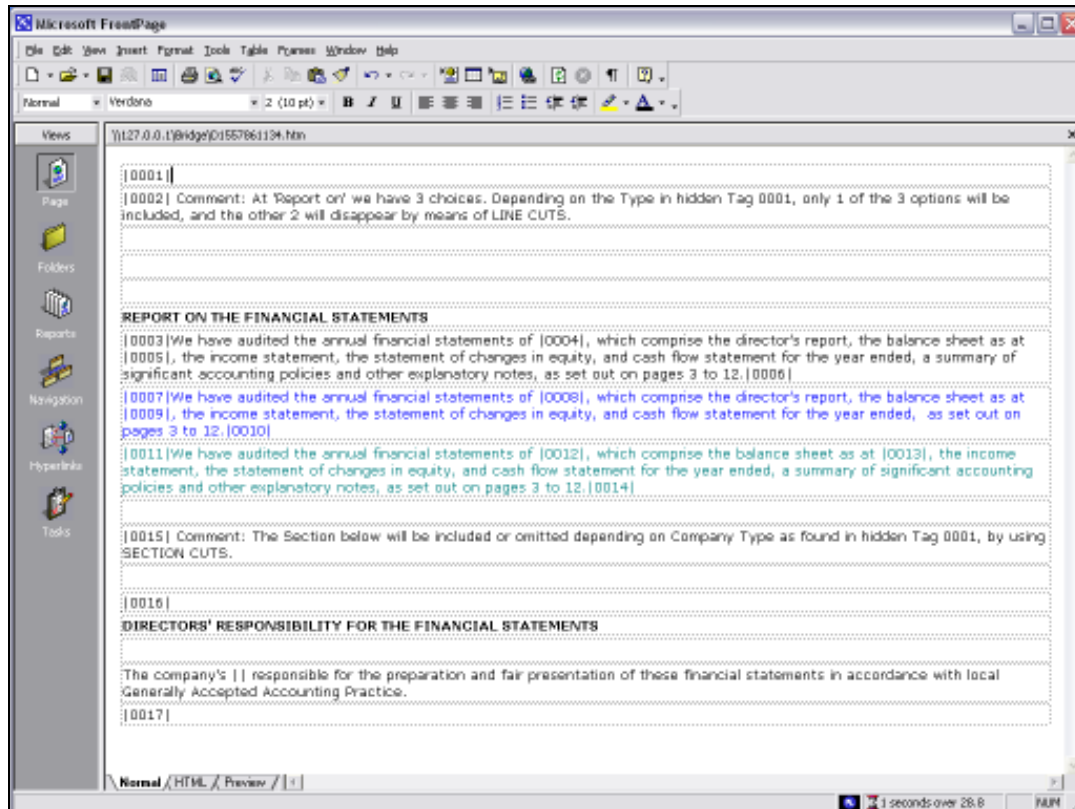

Slide notes: So we will replace this text with a Tag that will test how many Directors there are in the Company, and then decide which text to use.



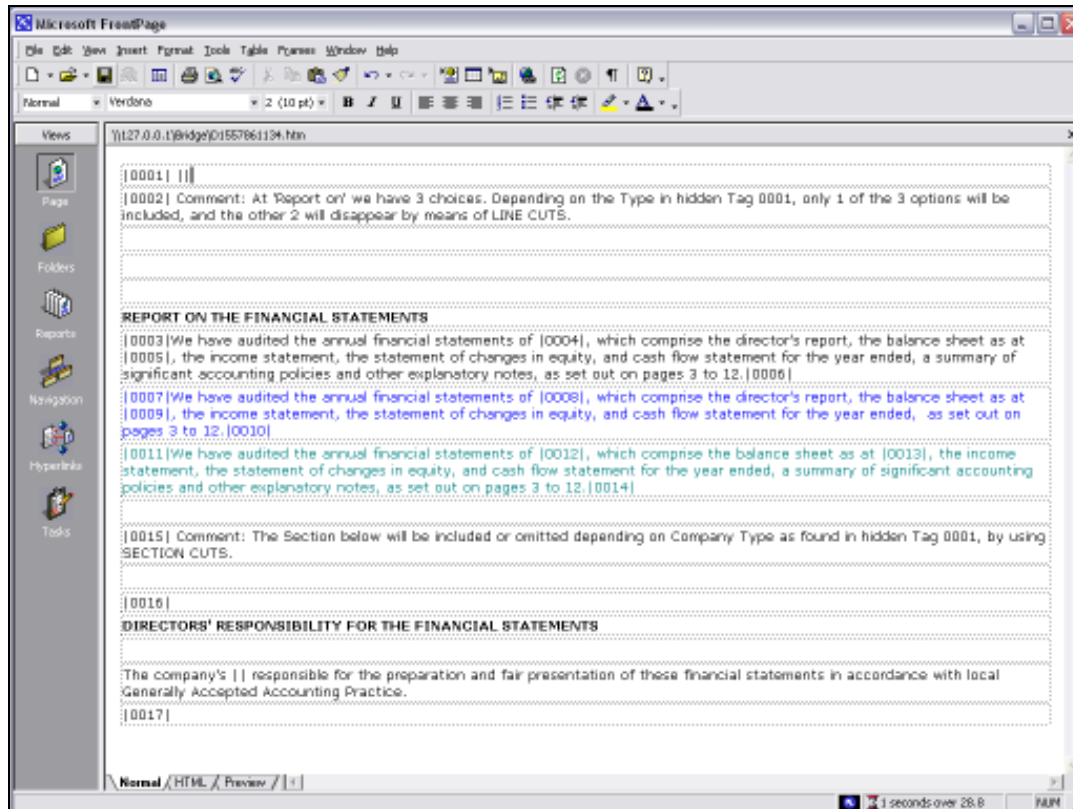

Slide notes: And for our 1st test we will say there is only 1 Director in the Company, and then we will see whether the Text Replacement works properly.



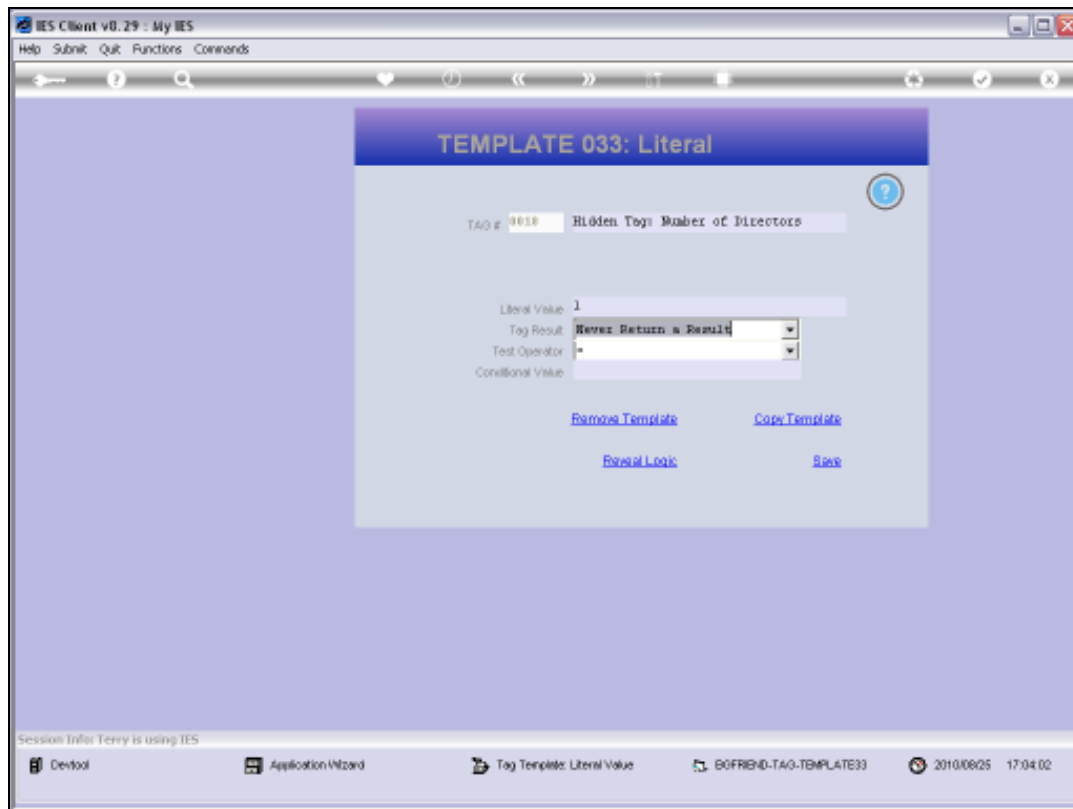
