
Slide notes: And the change is performed for us. After performing any mass updates, we should always re-generate the Tag Commands.





Slide notes: It is never unsafe to re-generate the commands. So if in doubt we can do it anyway, but essentially the system will always generate the latest Commands for a Tag when we work with a Tag Macro or Tag Template. But it does not do so automatically for Tag changes when we apply mass updates.
