




Slide notes: Let us consider this layout. It performs a Unit that is based on a Transaction selection of Purchase Order Invoice processing.







Slide notes: Each time the Report is performed, the User may make different selections with regards to Period and Transaction Ranges, and also Order Number pattern.



Slide notes: That means that we cannot predict what the User will choose, but we still would like that information in the Report headers, because it tells us what the Report Result is supposed to include. So how can we get that information into the Report itself?





Slide notes: This is the 2nd step of the Data Selection, and once again, the User is able to make different choices. Each choice the User makes is remembered.






Slide notes: And we are able to show those choices made by the User, in the Report.


Slide notes: The Transaction Select choices are only relevant if a Transaction Selection was actually performed for this Report, and the 'other' selection choices are always in sequence as appearing on the Data Selection screen performed by the User. Therefore, because our 'other' selection included only 1 option, i.e. Order Number pattern, then it must be the 1st choice of this group.




