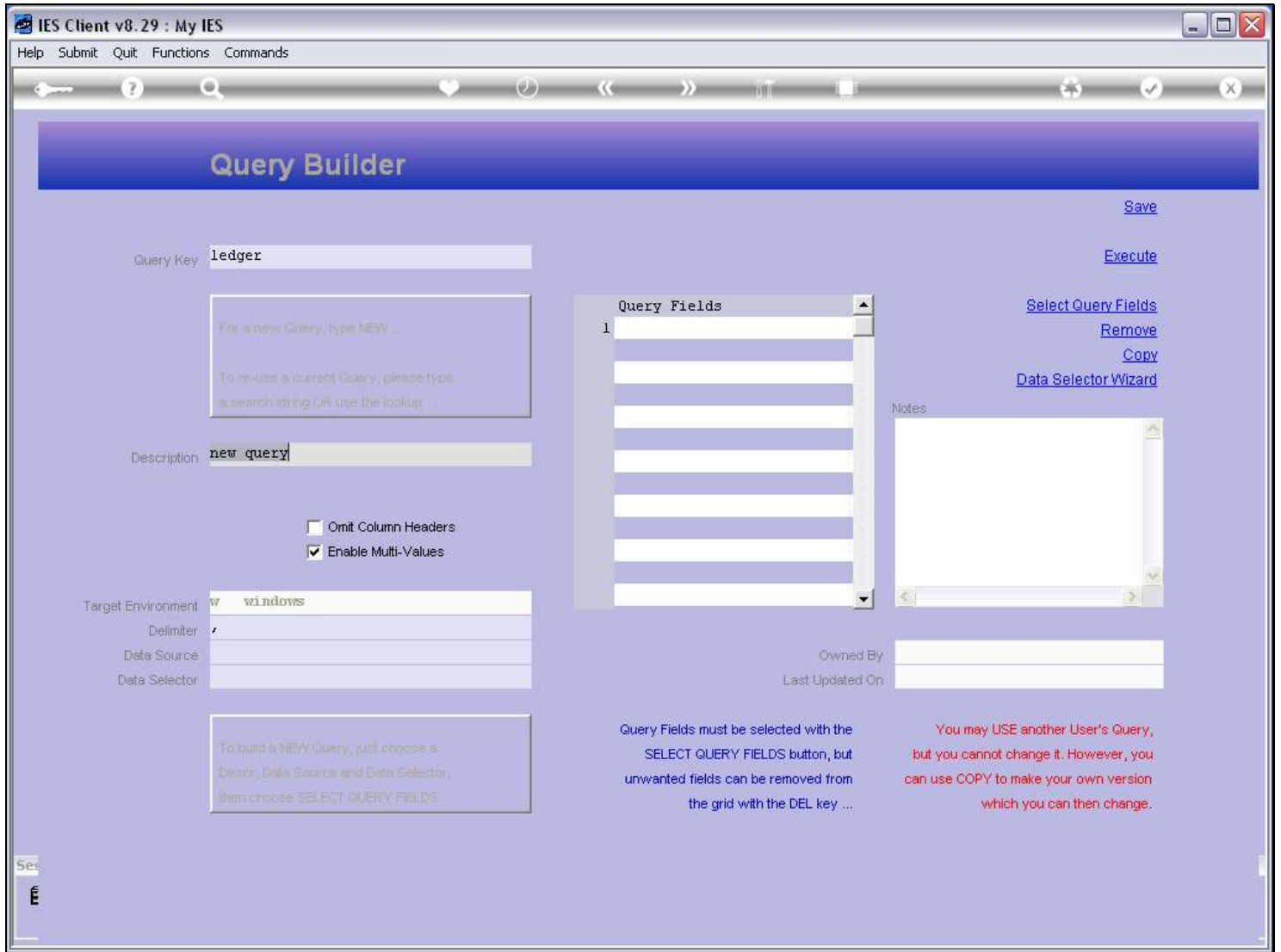

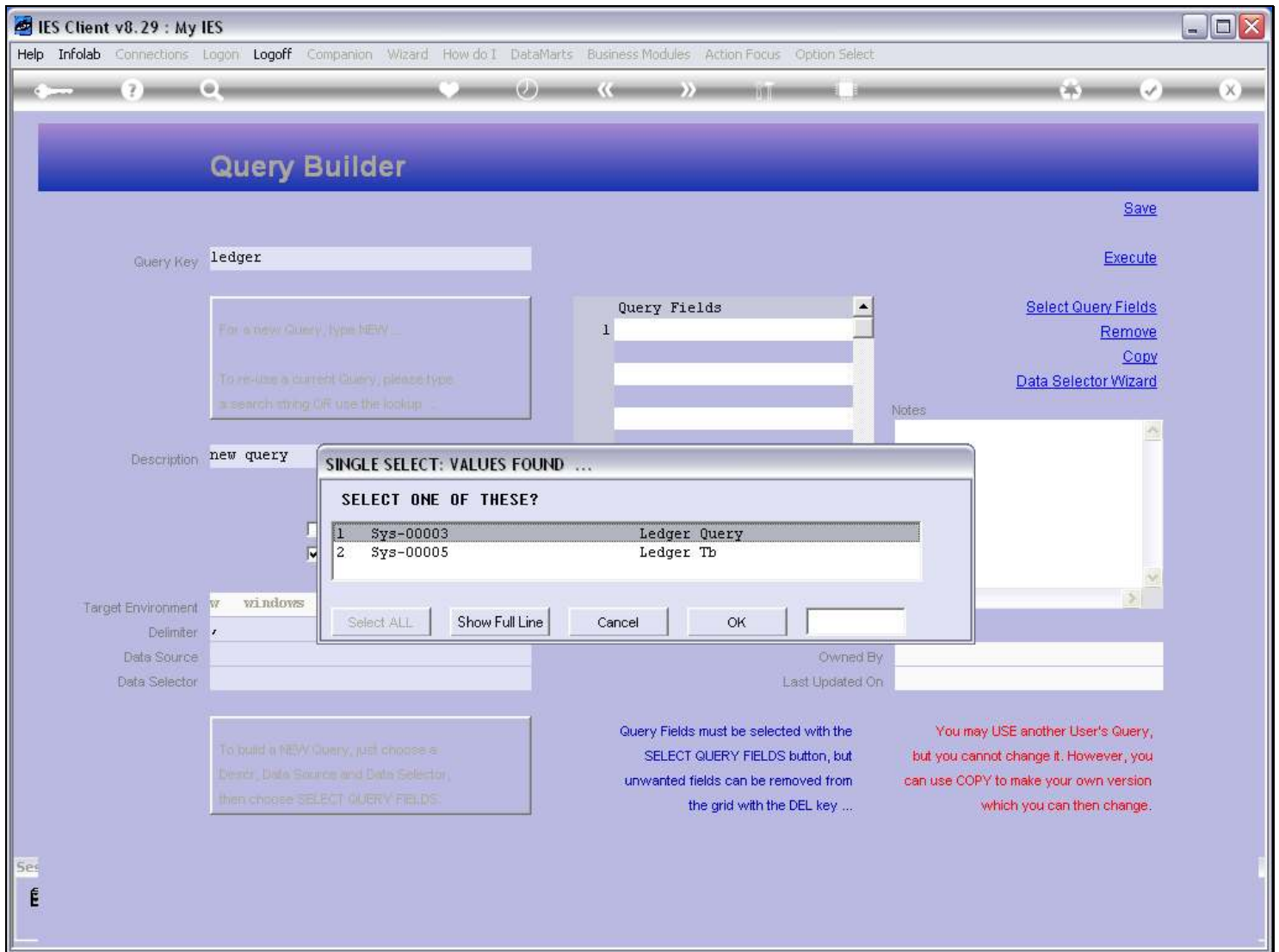
Any User may retrieve any existing Data Query with the lookup. That does not mean that the User can use or change the Query. A Query can be found by typing some part of the name of that Query.

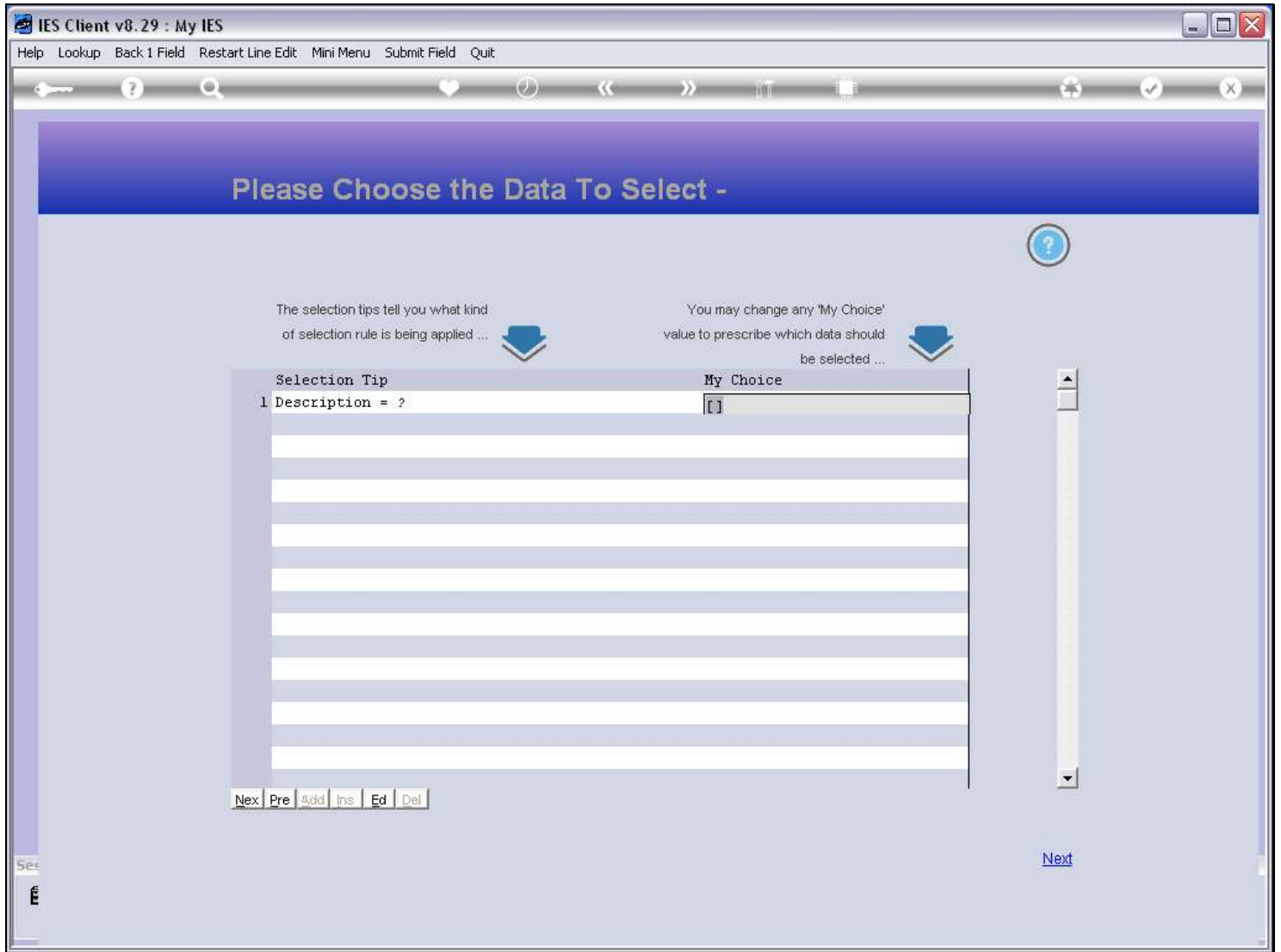
We can accept the default wildcards, which will find ALL Queries, or we can narrow the search by putting some search string within the wild cards.

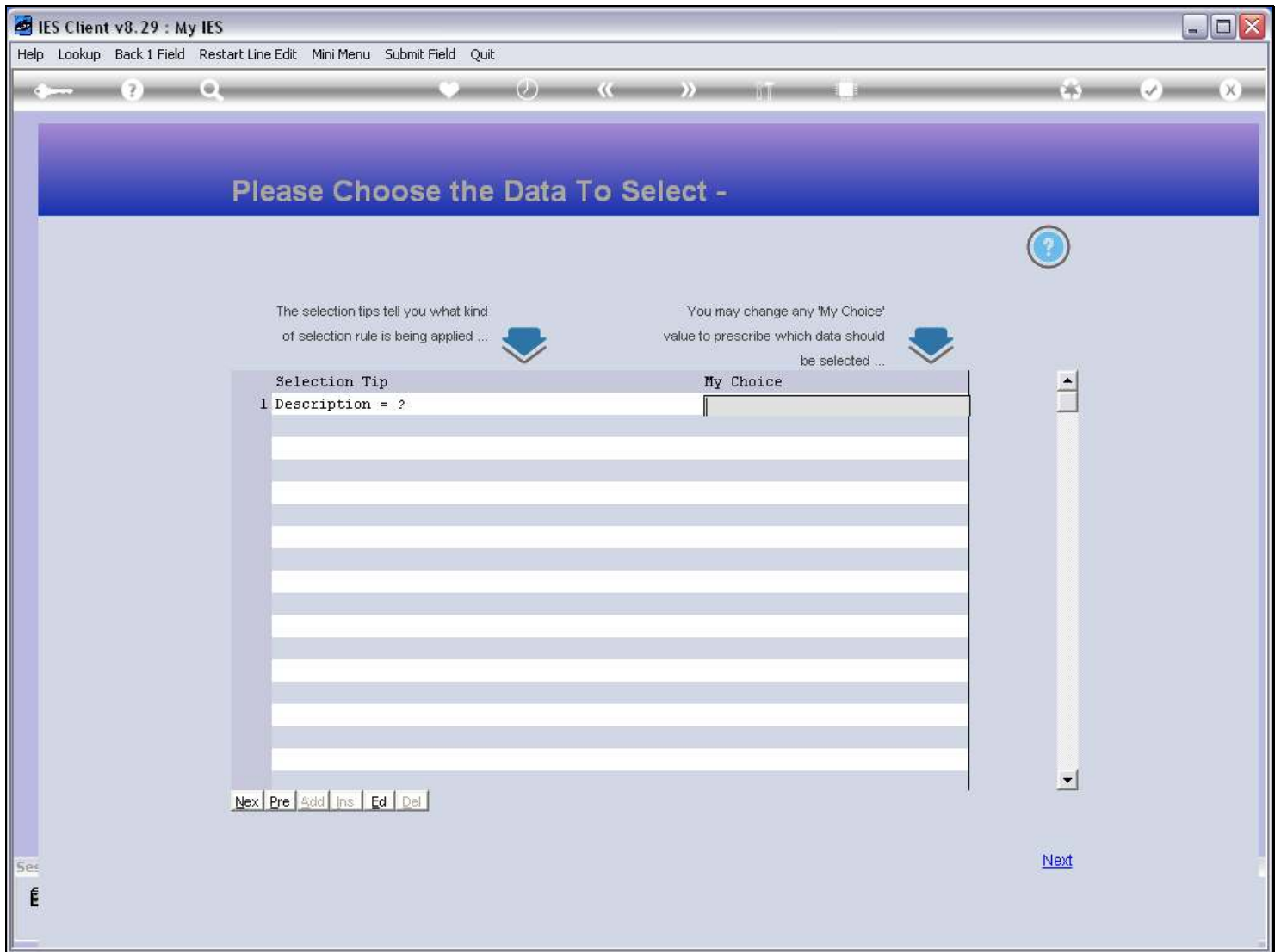
