


The Data Names that we use on our Report will become the columns of information in the Report output. We can capture, edit and type such Data Names, but the easiest method is to use 'Select Data Names'.

While we have the ID Suppress switched on, these 3 Data Names will result in 3 columns in the Report output. Let's try it and see.


