

Print Writer is an automator of Document Writer, which it uses to perform a DocWriter report, then gets it back from DocWriter and Prints it, opens it as a PDF or e-mails it. In other words, whereas DocWriter will perform a Document and then usually will offer an Open option to the User, it now gives it back to PrintWriter to automatically perform the designated action.



For the sake of easy recognition and management, we recommend to use the same Key as the DocWriter Key that will be executed, and then append it by '-p' or some other indicator, as required.





And we have to specify the DocWriter target object. When we look at this one, and then at the Key at the top, then we can see that we are using the same key at the top, with some extension.



It can automatically send the Report to a Printer, or make a PDF document from the html and then either open it or else send it off automatically by e-mail.



When the action is e-mail, it is important to use the correct setting here, because DocWriter itself may be writing a record to the 'DOCWRITESPRE' file on a key of either USER or PORT. So, in that case, we must be sure to use the OTHER option here to avoid a clash. Therefore, when we use the 'e-mail' action, we will check the DocWriter object to see which of the 2 settings it is already using, and then choose the other setting here.
