


Slide 1 Slide notes: The Reports menu include a 'Human Resources' item with a number of options for HR related Reports.



Slide 2 Slide notes: It is optional to use the Human Resource Recharge Register with Job Costing, and if we do, then the options shown here are meaningful.





Slide notes: And the Division option lists the Divisions, inclusive of Teams in those Divisions.



Slide notes: Productivity indicators can be produced for any selected Period Range, either with Detail or as a Summary. We can include all or a selected Division.



Slide notes: This is a Productivity Report with Detail.




