



Slide notes: To find or select the specific Account that will be duplicated, we have all these available methods.






Slide notes: In this example, we are using an Account in the stated Department.






Slide notes: The Cost Centre that we used is the one we are stating here. This is by no means the only method to list the Accounts. It is simply an opportune one to use now.






Slide notes: And here we can clearly see how 'Artisan Wages' has been duplicated for a series of different Activities.




