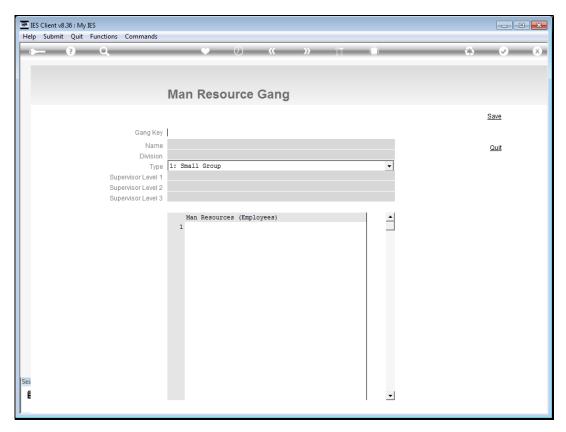
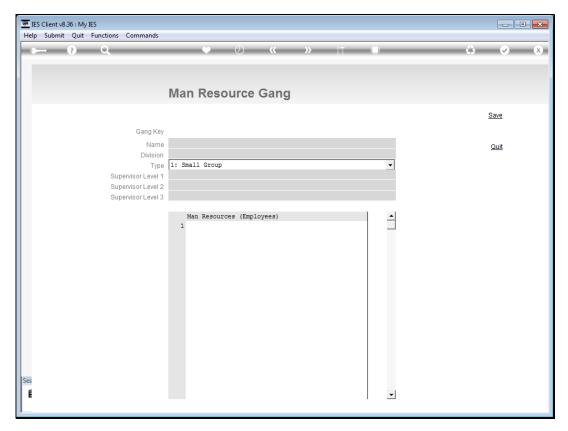


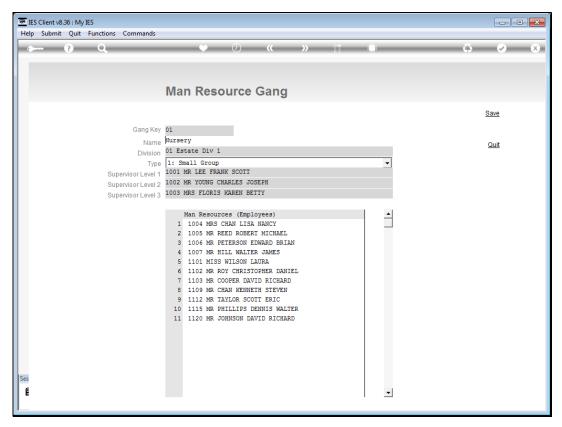

Slide notes: Man Gangs are essential for Man Physicals processing. The attendance records and the Man Journals populate Employees automatically onto the record after selection of the Gang.



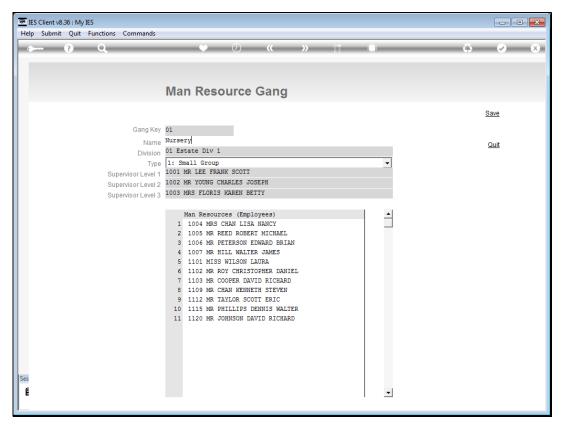

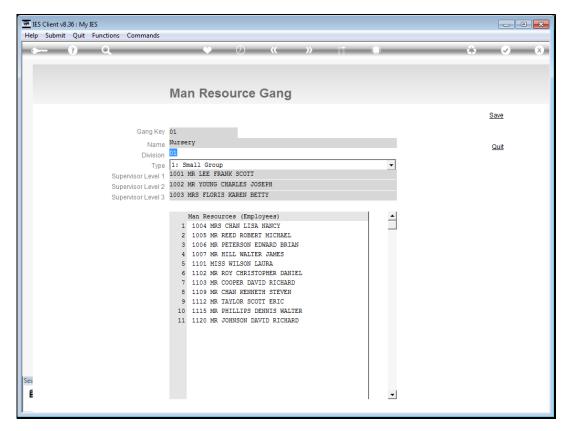

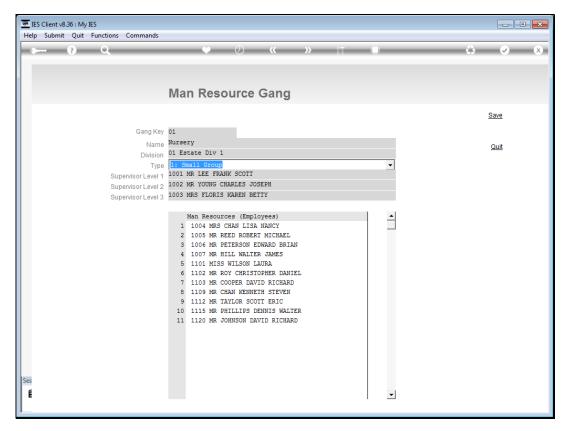

Slide notes: We can choose any method to number the Gangs and we give each Gang a Name.



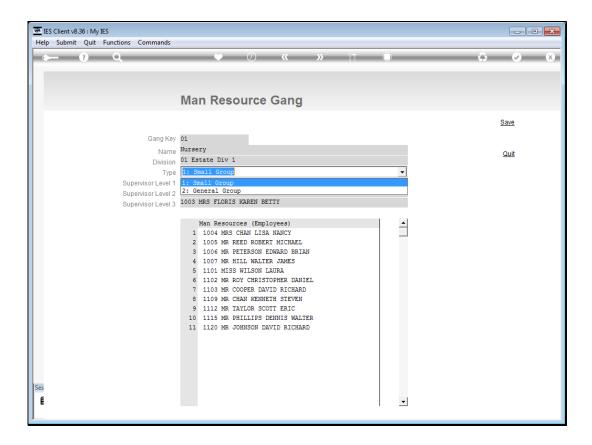
