
Slide notes: This Item still needs the Price to be confirmed, and of course, because it is a Direct Item, it also needs a final Allocation.





Slide notes: The system offers to apply the User's Allocation as the final Allocation.





Slide notes: And as such, we have confirmed the Price and performed the final Allocation now in the same step.




Slide notes: Only Direct Items need a Purchase Order Allocation, because Stock Items will automatically be charged to Stock.





Usually, when the Price is higher than originally authorized or if only in 1st Authorization, then the Request will have to go back to the Nominee for Final Authorization.




