

Slide notes: While we are scanning Items, it is sometimes more convenient to change a Quantity than to scan more of the same Item any number of times. Therefore, we have a number of useful 'one touch' options to change the last Quantity.









Slide notes: And we have an option to reduce the last quantity by 1.





Slide notes: We also have an option to specify a specific quantity for the last Item.




