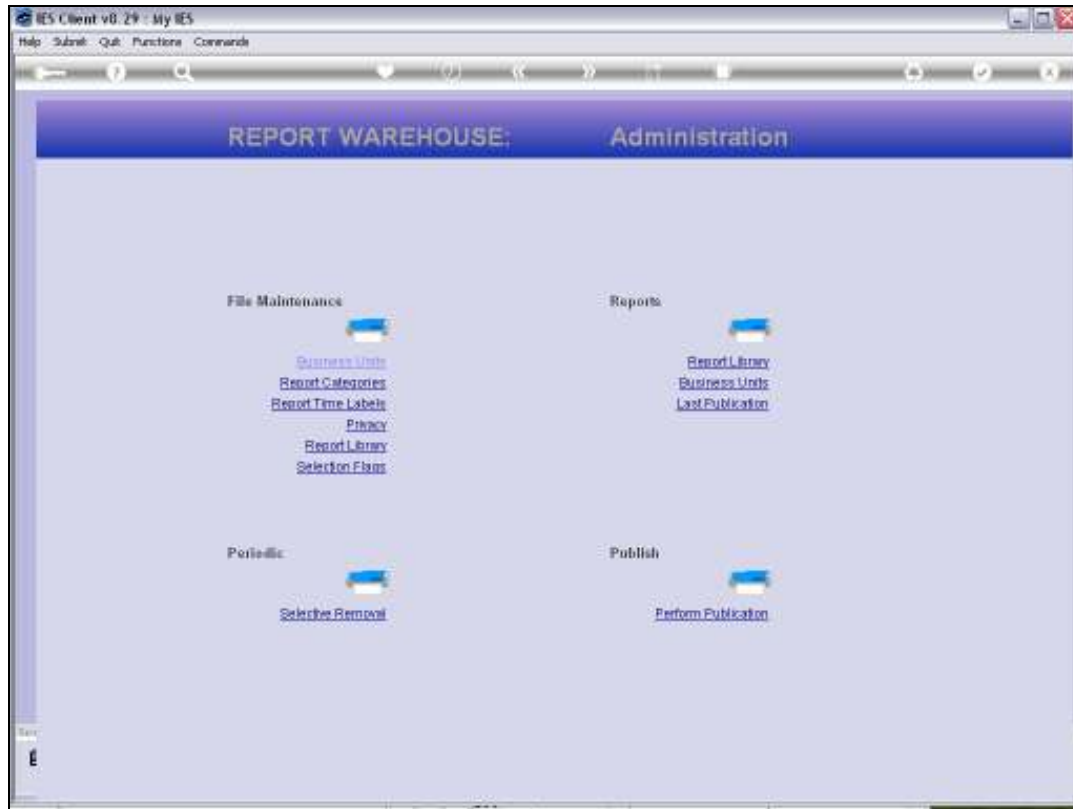


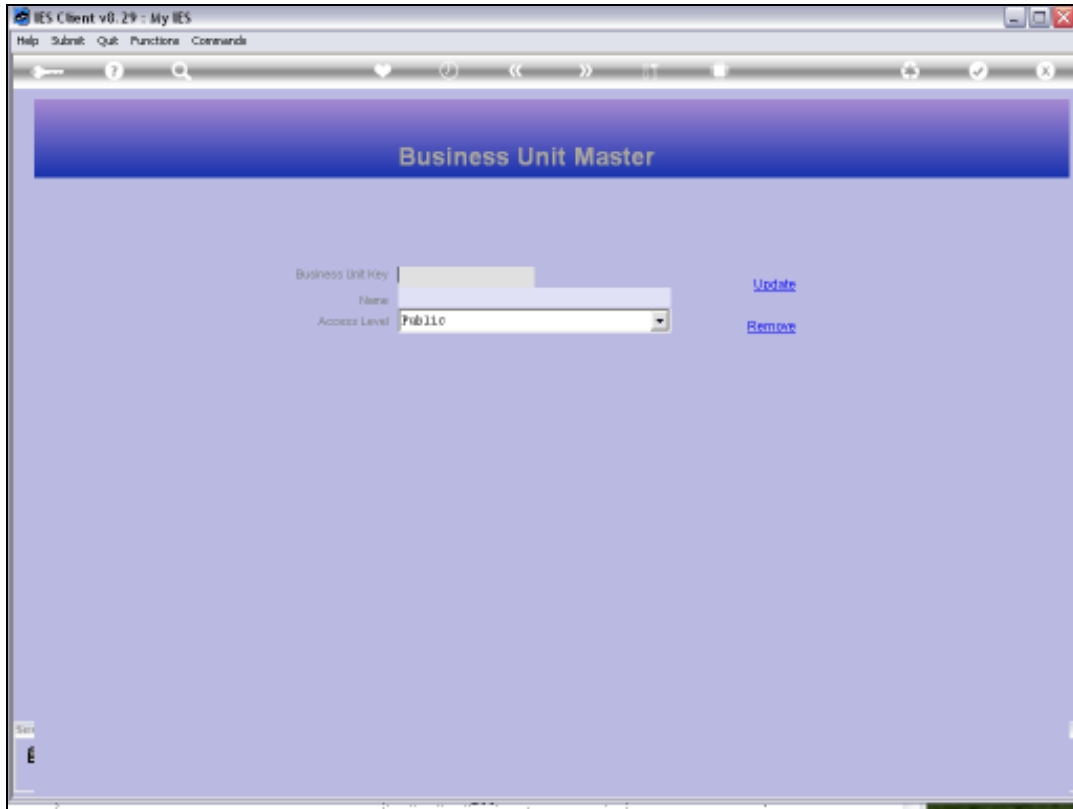
## Slide 1

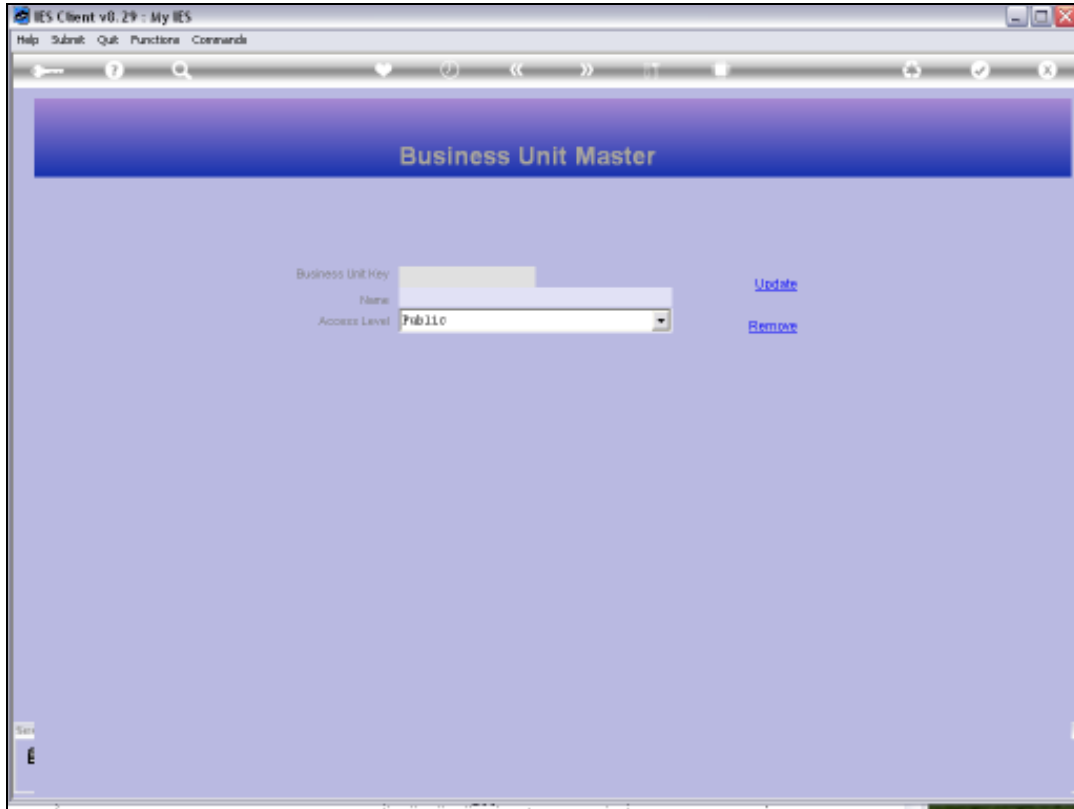

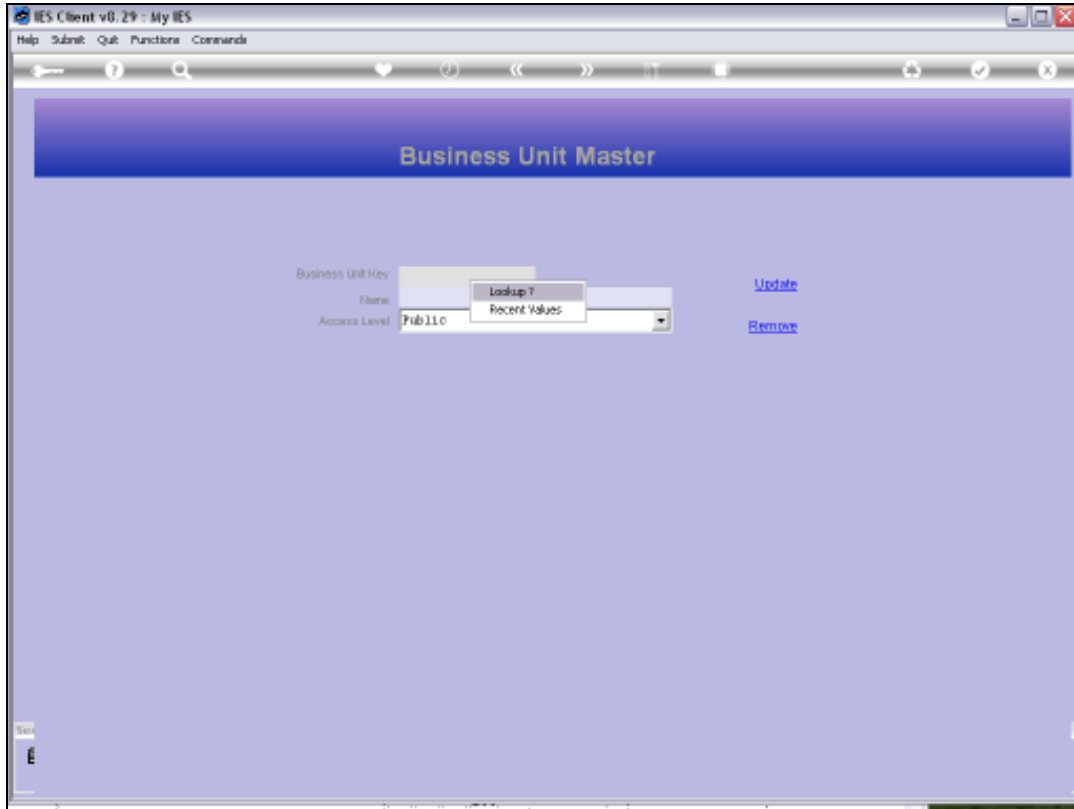
Slide notes: Only System Administrators have access to this part of the Warehouse.



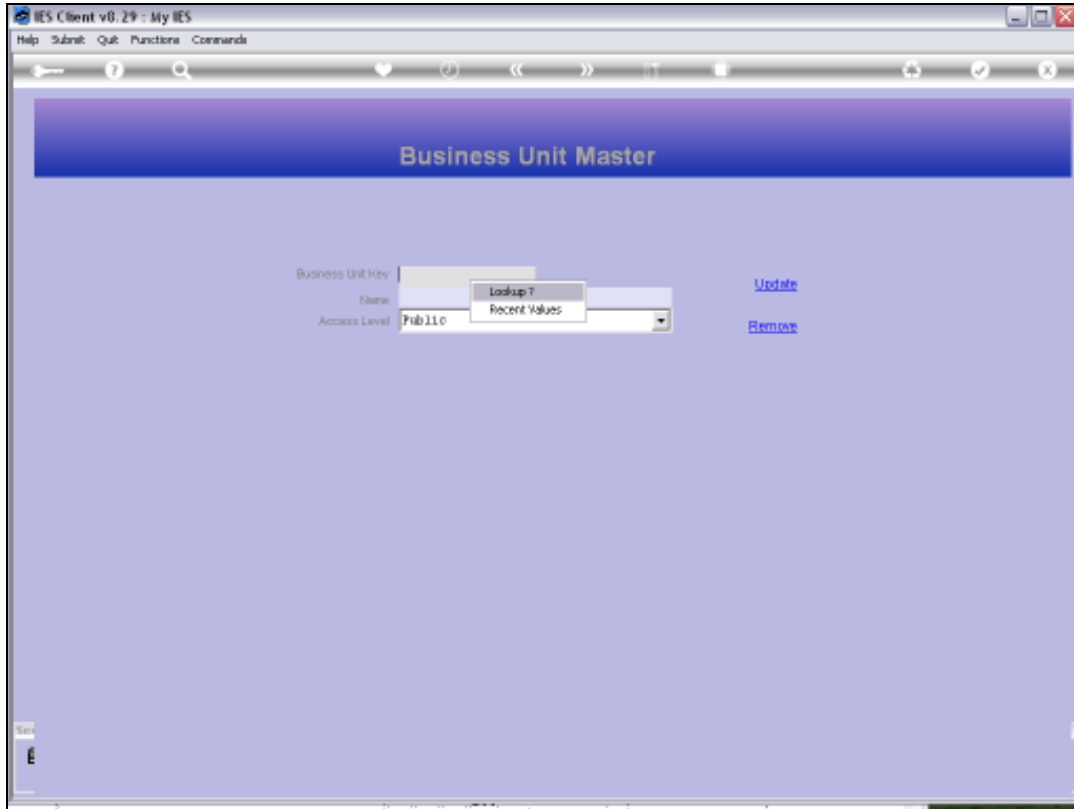

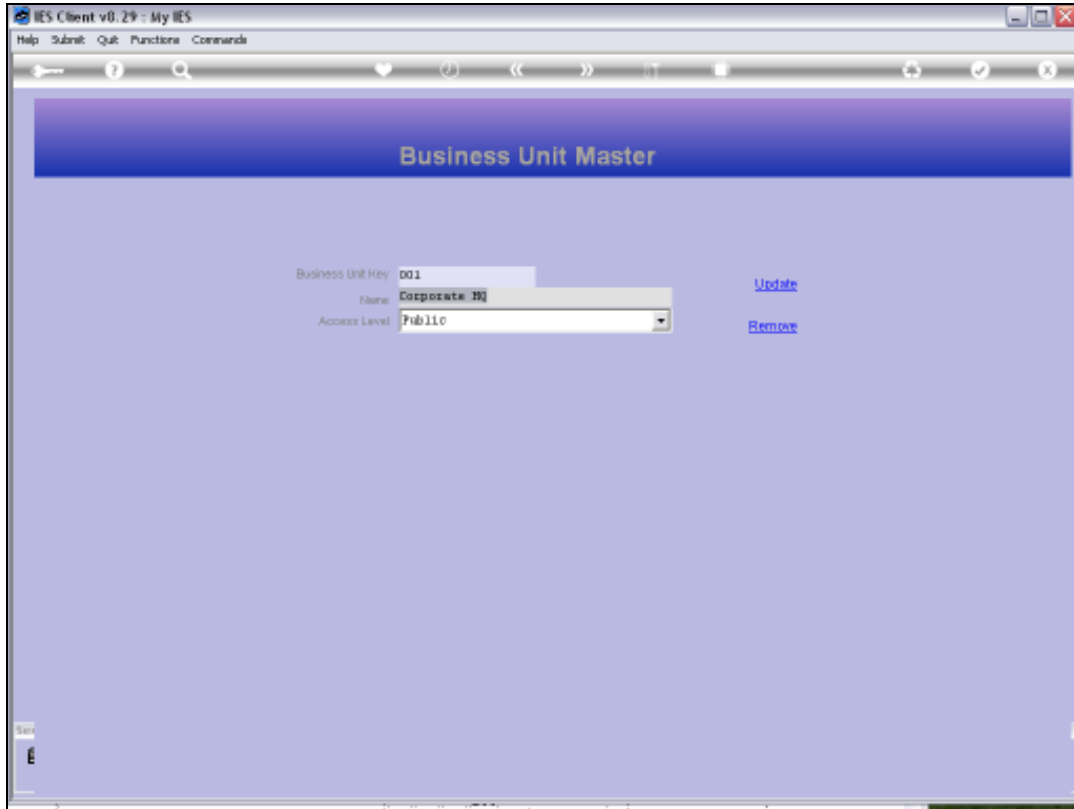
Slide notes: Here we see a number of existing Business Units that have already been listed for this Report Warehouse.



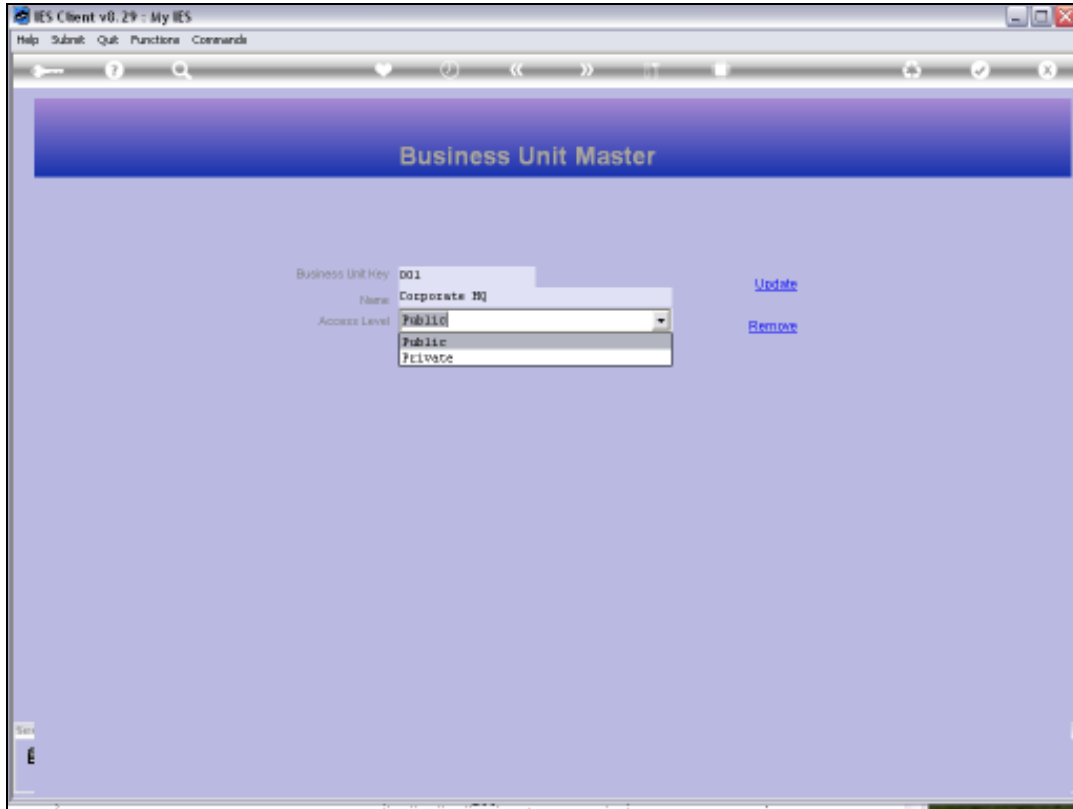
### Slide 8

Slide notes: Every Business Unit gets a 3 digit Key, and a Name, and of course we can invent any Names that we need.



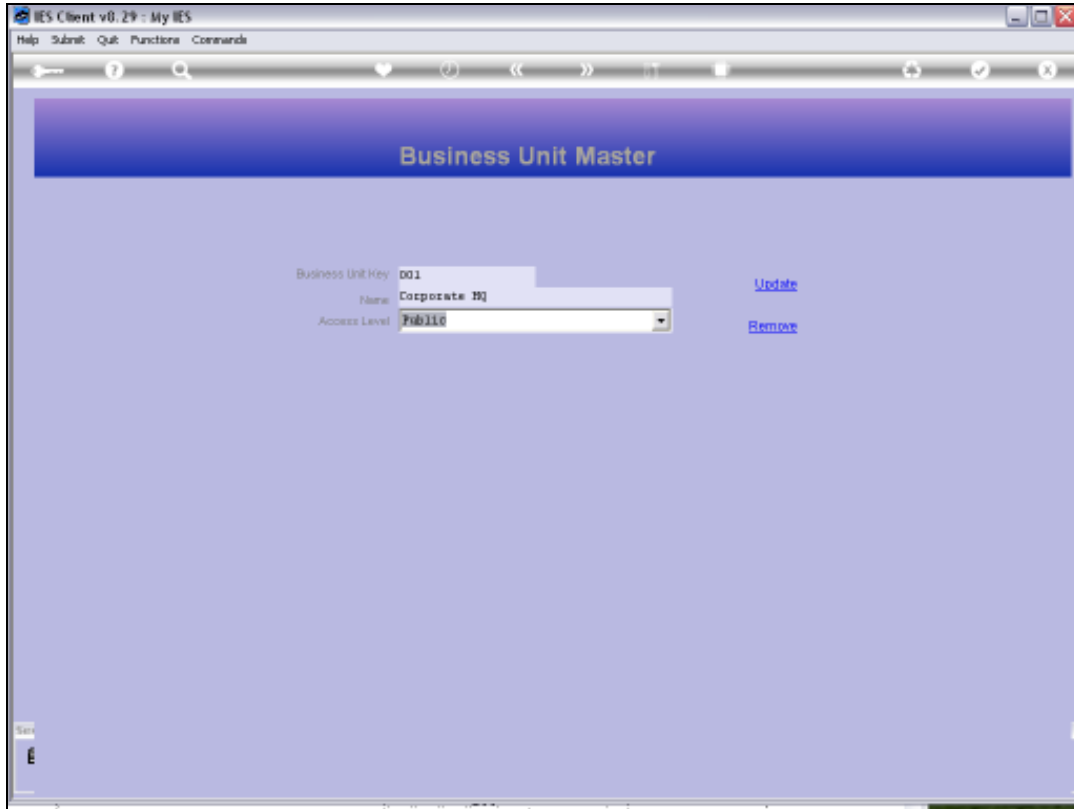

Slide notes: On the Help it is explained that only 3 digit Keys are allowed for the Business Units.

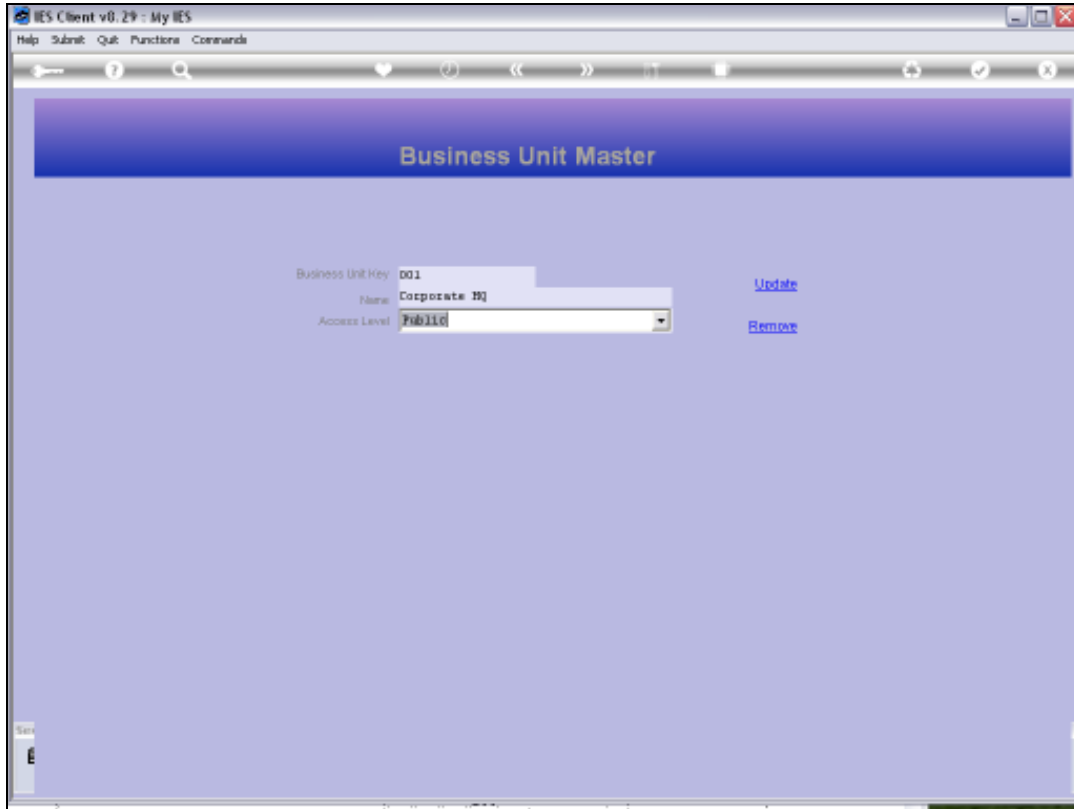

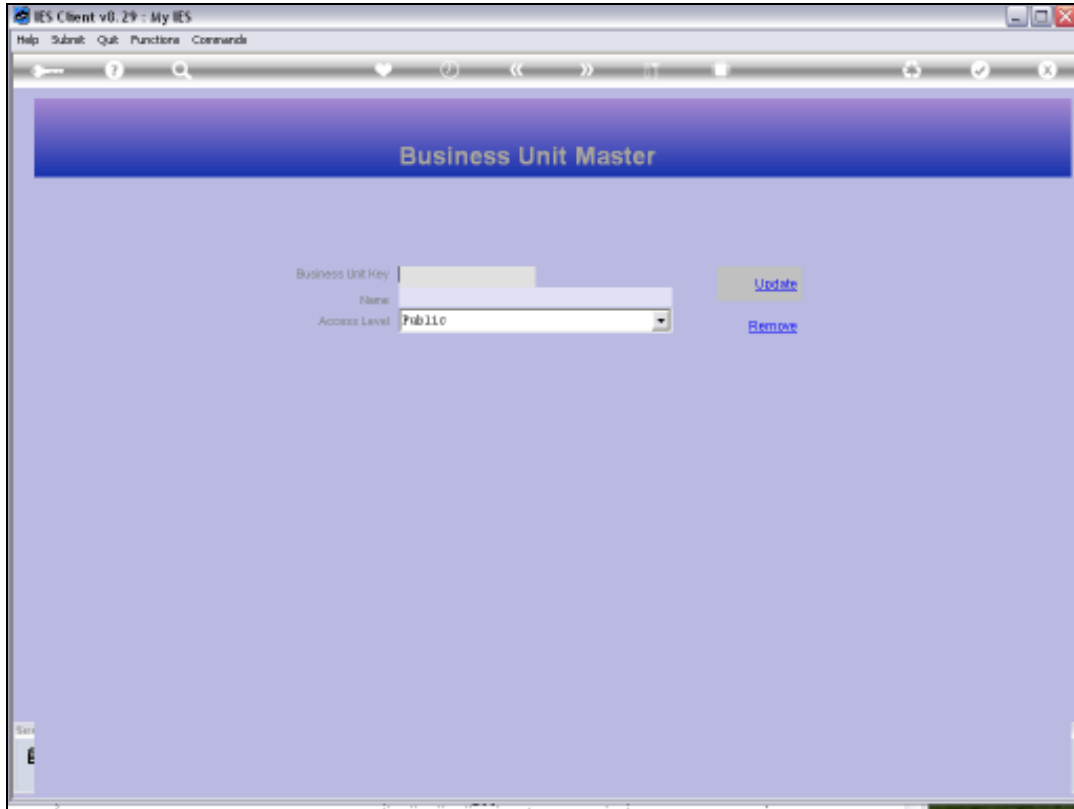
### Slide 17
